As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog - Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if it is a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes and MUST be indicated as "GET" in the additional class box on the entry form. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if he has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or standard for the Breed.

Brood Bitch - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - Two identical ownership, regardless of sex. Will require a fee of \$20.00 for the Brace as a Unit if entered as an additional class. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a brace is not entered in another class it must be entered "For Brace Only", fee is \$25.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class." If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1" "Brace No. 2" etc.

ALL Sweepstakes classes are \$20.00 each. Dogs entered in the Sweepstakes must be entered in a regular class.

RALLY IS A SEPARATE EVENT AT A FULL ENTRY FEE OF \$25.00. SECOND ENTRY OF THE SAME DOG IN RALLY IS \$20.00. ENTERING RALLY AS WELL AS A CLASS IN THE SPECIALTY SHOW DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A SECOND ENTRY OF THE SAME DOG. FULL ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID FOR THE SPECIALTY SHOW AS WELL AS THE RALLY TRIAL.

Rally Entry Fee includes the \$3.00 per entry AKC Recording Fee.
RALLY ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE THE DOG'S JUMP HEIGHT.

MAKE ALL CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO GREAT PYRENEES CLUB OF METROPOLITAN MILWAUKEE. USE OF CREDIT CARDS FOR PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES IS NOT ACCEPTED.

Entry fees include \$3.00 per entry AKC Event
Service fee and the recording fee of \$0.50 for the first entry of each dog.

ENTRIES which are not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of such WHICH DO NOT HAVE THE AGREEMENT AND RULES ON THE REVERSE SIDE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

A SERVICE CHARGE of \$25.00 will be made for ALL NSF checks. This fee along with the entry fee must be paid in cash on the day of the show, or the dogs entered will not be allowed to be shown.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. No entry shall be made or will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry fees WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. IF BECAUSE OF RIOTS, CIVIL DISTURBANCES, FIRE, AN ACT OF GOD, PUBLIC EMERGENCY, ACT OF A PUBLIC ENEMY, STRIKES OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE GREATER MILWAUKEE GREAT PYRENEES CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUNDS OF ANY ENTRY FEES WILL BE MADE.

Entry fees for Obedience Trial or Rally Trial will not be refunded for bitches that come into season after entries close.

OWNERS are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry will be refunded in the event of such errors.

ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED, CANCELED OR CHANGED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

MOVE UPS WILL BE ALLOWED AT THIS RALLY TRIAL AS PER AKC REGULATIONS.

Space will not be provided for un-entered dogs.

Refreshments will be available on the grounds.

The Great Pyrenees Club of Metropolitan Milwaukee will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, injury or death of any dog at this show.

There is limited indoor grooming available. Please clean up your grooming area before you leave the show site.

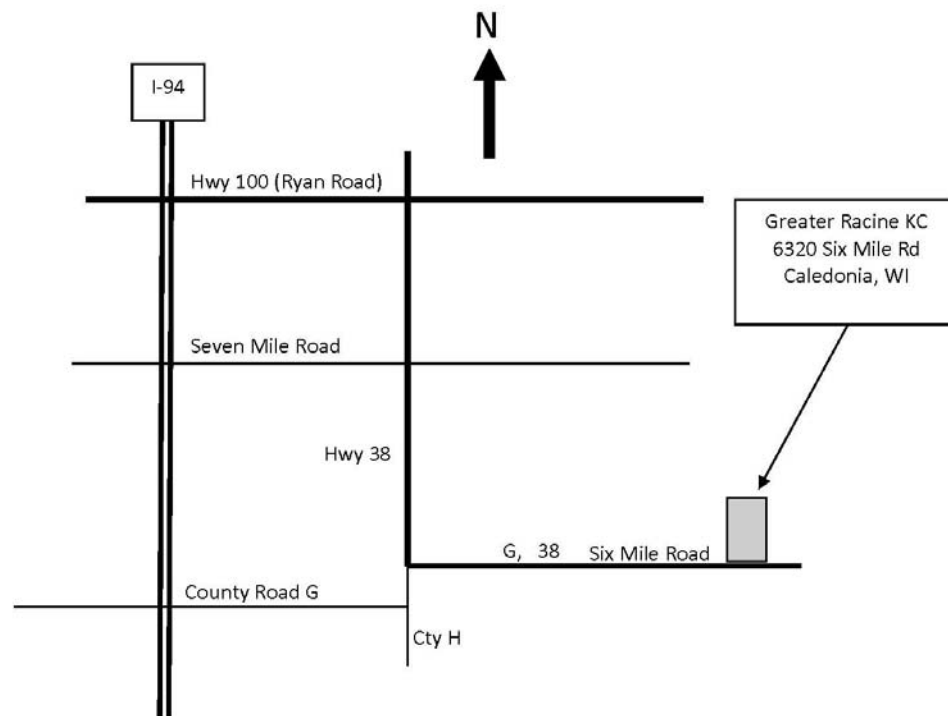
